行程 A: 札幌-国际滑雪场

去程: 札幌车站(08: 45 出发) 札幌国际滑雪场(约 10: 10 抵达)

回程: 札幌国际滑雪场(17:00 出发) 札幌车站(约 18:30 抵达)

【札幌国际滑雪场】札幌国际滑雪场是札幌地区规模最大的滑雪场,以接近野雪感觉的山地林间

滑雪为特色,雪道最高处海拔可达 1100 米,按照坡度、长度和宽度分为五条雪道,其中一条高级雪道,一条初级雪道,两条初中级雪道,以及两条中级雪道。其中最长的雪道为面向初级的林间雪道,全长可达 3.6 千米,即使是初级雪道,难度仍然达到甚至超过了很多滑雪场的中级雪道。来到札幌国际滑雪场,凭借著雪道的长度和难度,结合滑雪教练的专业指导,

行程 B: 札幌-札幌手稻滑雪场

去程: 札幌车站 (9:00 出发) 札幌手稻滑雪场(约 10:00 抵达)

回程: 札幌手稻滑雪场(17:00 出发) 札幌车站(约 18:00 抵达)

【札幌手稻滑雪场】每年都有北海道内外各地的滑雪爱好者云集于此。在手稻山上眺望,左边有石狩湾,正面是札幌市区以及远处连绵的大雪山,而右边则是波光粼粼一望无际的太平洋。您能够置身于如此超群的景观之中,尽情体验滑雪的乐趣。本滑雪场为 1972 年在亚洲举办的冬季奥运会——札幌冬奥会的赛场,具有能够满足中上级滑雪爱好者的场地设置。札幌手稻



滑雪场分为"高地区"与"奥林匹亚区"两个区域,在"奥林匹亚区"中,原封不动地保留着冬奥会的圣火台。连接两个区域的"彩虹赛道"是起始于山顶的超长赛道,能够给您带来最长滑行距离 5.4 公里的超凡体验。2008 年 12 月,秒速 5m,4 人乘坐的厢式高速登山索道"峰会特快"的登场,使得从山脚到山顶仅需 4 分钟,让您能够享受到快捷便利的滑雪之旅。

行程 C: 札幌-留寿都度假滑雪场

去程: 札幌车站(8: 30 出发) 留寿都度假滑雪场(约 10: 00 抵达) 回程: 留寿都度假滑雪(17:00 出发) 札幌车站(约 18: 30 抵达)

【留寿都度假滑雪场】留寿都滑雪场是北海道第一大滑雪场,位于北海道西南面,是滑雪爱好者熟悉的滑雪胜地。日本人习惯将北海道的雪称为粉末雪,因为此种雪摸起来干干爽爽的,质地柔轻松散,滑起来也就格外轻快与舒服,容易控制,不易受伤。身为全北海道最大滑雪场的留寿都,由 3 个山组成,26 个滑雪点,滑雪道很多,当中包括了3,500 米长的滑雪道,初学人士可以使用家庭滑雪道,适合不同程度的滑雪



人士使用。场内的多种登山缆车,每小时可以运载 25,200 人上山,非常方便。

行程 D: 札幌-KIRORO 雪世界

【KIRORO 雪世界】

余市郡的 KIRORO 雪世界拥有 21 个滑雪道, 五座高速缆车, 最高的顶峰有近千米高度, 坐缆车也需 10 分钟左右。从山 顶往下看, 雪道几近垂直, 这对于喜欢刺激的滑雪高手来 说很具有挑战的享受。不过像我们这样的菜鸟, 只能在坡 面 16 度的初级道上撒撒野。乘敞开式的缆车上去, 然后尽 情地往下划, 照样可以体验速度带来的快感。KIRORO 里也 有儿童雪道。好多七八岁的小孩全副武装, 教练们带着他



们在雪道上做准备操,小孩们见到满山遍野的厚雪开心地在雪地里直打滚。如果小朋友们只是想 玩玩雪的话,在雪场边上有个雪上乐园,有雪上摩托车和雪车等多样设施,可以体验这里的冰雪 世界。

行程 E: 札幌车站-日本二世古国际比罗夫滑雪场

【日本二世古国际比罗夫滑雪场】位于北海道最负盛名及风景优美的滑雪胜地之一。二世古自古

就是滑雪场,素有东洋"桑莫历弛"之称。这个雪上 王国坐落在札幌西南面的二世古 Annpuri 山。三座 巨型滑雪场分别坐落在二世古 Annupuri 山的三面, 它们分别是:二世古国际 Annpuri 滑雪场,二世古 东山滑雪场,二十国国际比罗夫滑雪场。地理环境得 天独厚,它的场地遍及三个山头,有山顶相连(分别 是难度最高的东山滑雪场,中等难度的比罗夫滑雪



场及难度较低的 Annipuri 国际滑雪场),比罗夫滑雪场是二世古最大型的一个滑雪场,总共 34 条学道。

		Plan A: Sapporo-Sapporo Kokusai Skiing Resort Depart: Sapporo Station (08: 45) Sapporo Kokusai Skiing Resort (arrive at 10:00) Return: Sapporo Kokusai Skiing Resort (17: 00) Sapporo Station (arrive at 18: 30) [Sapporo Kokusai Skiing Resort] This ski resort features seven different 7 courses for skiers of varying abilities. It is a comprehensive ski resort located near the Jozankei Hot Springs. Among the ski resorts in the Sapporo area, it has a long season starting in mid November and ending in early May. There are seven courses for beginners to advanced skiers and a snow park for sledding and tubing. The Woody Trail and Fairy Tale Trail for beginners is a satisfying 3.6km course. For those who like to mogul, there is a downhill course with a 30° slope. For snowboarders, there is a snowboard park with tabletops and jump ramps. It's also nice that it's located near the Jozankei Hot Springs.

It is frequented by beginners yet it also caters really well to day-tripping powder hounds who want powder lines that are steep, deep and cheap. Sapporo Teine is made up of two small areas, Olympia and Highland. Sapporo Teine Olympia was the site of the bobsled competition for the 1972 Sapporo Olympic Games. Olympia still has the old Olympic flame tower as well as various other reminders of a bygone era. The Teine Olympia ski area offers delightfully mellow slopes for beginners as well as night skiing.

[Rusutsu Resort Japan] Enter the Rusutsu white room! The Rusutsu Ski Resort in Hokkaido is

absolute heaven for experienced powder hounds or powder hounds on their "L" plates. With an average annual snowfall of over 14 metres, the Rusutsu Resort has some of the most incredible powder and tree skiing to be found anywhere in the world. Frequently the powder is incredibly dry; you blast right through it with virtually no resistance. It's absolute bliss! Rusutsu



Hokkaido is great for a day trip from Niseko to experience some Japow nirvana, but it's even better if you book a multi-day stay at Rusutsu.
